From my perspective, this has been one of the smoothest years for the FRSL that I've been involved in. This season our registrations held steady with last year's numbers, meaning we could keep relatively the same structure in most of our divisions. As always though, people age and interests change, causing a shift in division numbers. We've tried to work around this as much as possible to avoid uneven teams and Bye Rounds but weren't completely successful. That said, you may have noticed some changes we made this season to try and develop the League. Some of these changes include the restarting of a Netball League, registration through our website and the increase in the number of games to slightly increase the length of the season (and your value for money).

We give a big thanks to Cheryl Versluis and Coral De Snoo for running the Netball League this season, getting it set up and working was no small task. The Netball has come under the FRSL banner at this point and is using our website and comes under our arrangement with Kwinana for use of the facilities. I should note here, that the netball has had hardly any effect on registration numbers for the soccer. We hope to grow both Leagues into the future.

With regards to registration through the website, there were a few hiccoughs but they were resolved fairly quickly and the registration went relatively smoothly from our perspective. If you have any feedback regarding registration or suggestions we could take on board, please feel free to send in an email. We're still expecting to refine the website a little over the next few years so any suggestions are welcomed.

One of the last (but not least) things I wish to mention are our sponsors. This season we've found sponsors for several new kits, advertising their logos on the shirts. LOOK, LOCK, LEAVE

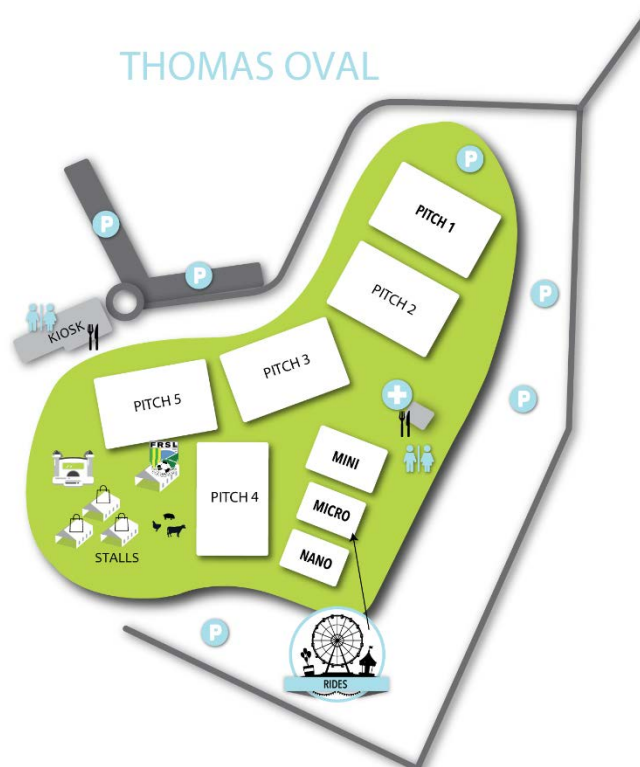
With lots of people comes lots of attention and not all of it positive. Please don't leave valuables in your cars.
